"STRONGHOLDS OF PRIDE"

Words of prophecy:

JESUS

* As I walked in My earthly ministry, Satan had established his "strongholds of pride" in many of the Pharisees - and, thus, they rejected Me and all that I stood for [the Heart and Will of the Father]. So too, now, in these days there are many who are bound by a stronghold of pride in the midst of the congregations.

And, unless a deep and thorough repentance [change of heart] is forthcoming [both individually and corporately] THEN they will be immersed in the deep darkness that "wilful pride" SURELY brings - and, thus, they will not have "ears to hear" or "eyes to see" My Glory rise in the earth in the midst of [and through] a people that have made the Third Heaven their home [dwelling place] in this most critical and glorious hour.

...."Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites, because you travel around on sea and land to make one proselyte; and when he becomes one, you make him twice as much a son of hell as yourselves".... Matthew 23:15 NASB

...."Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in [the Third] heaven will enter. Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?' And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you [you were not authorized by Me in the secret place of My Father's Presence {the Third Heaven}]; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness [self-will]' ".... The Father does not entrust His Authority to the "self-righteous" *[or the "SELF-confident"]* for at the very root of their heart remains a "quest for self-glory" and the approval and praises of "flesh and blood" - as well as a certain reliance upon, and trust in, their "own" understanding.
