REFLECTIONS OF THE FATHER'S HEART

[Exhortations From The Father]

[April 4th]

* It is the heart that truly desires to discern between that which is righteous and that which is unrighteous that wll allow the "Jedidiah Anointing" to operate freely - both in them and through them.

"Jedidiah" - beloved of the Lord; Jedidiah [Solomon] is a type and pattern of Jesus and the Glorious {remnant} Church;

The Jedidiah Anointing:

This anointing speaks of intimacy - in the sense that if one is "the beloved of the Lord" they have continual access to Him in that place of extreme closeness - and, therefore, they are able take that which has been imparted to them in the Throne Room [Heaven] and impart it to His people on earth. This anointing is the "essence" of all true apostolic [Third Day] ministry.

...."How blessed [divinely empowered and prospered] is the one whom You choose and bring near [to You] To dwell in Your courts".... Psalms 65:4 NASB

...."the LORD appeared to Jedidiah [Solomon] in a dream at night; and God said, "Ask what you wish Me to give you."

Then Jedidiah [Solomon] said,

"Give Your servant an understanding heart to judge Your people to discern between good and evil. For who is able to judge this great people of Yours?"

"It was pleasing in the sight of the Lord that Jedidiah [Solomon] had asked this thing. God said to him,

"Because you have asked this thing and have not asked for yourself long life, nor have asked riches for yourself, nor have you asked for the life of your enemies, but have asked for yourself discernment to understand justice, behold, I

have done according to your words. Behold, I have given you a wise and discerning heart, so that there has been no one like you before you, nor shall one like you arise after you. I have also given you what you have not asked, both riches and honor, so that there will not be any among the kings like you all your days".... 1 Kings 3:5-13 NASB

...."Now God gave Jedidiah [Solomon] wisdom and very great discernment and breadth of mind, like the sand that is on the seashore. Jedidiah's [Solomon's] wisdom surpassed the wisdom of all the sons of the east and all the wisdom of Egypt. For he was wiser than all men.... and his fame was known in all the surrounding nations. He also spoke 3,000 proverbs, and his songs were 1,005..... Men came from all peoples to hear the wisdom of Jedidiah [Solomon], from all the kings of the earth who had heard of his wisdom".... 1 Kings 4:29-34 NASB

...."The LORD gave wisdom to Jedidiah [Solomon], just as He promised him".... 1 Kings 5:12 NASB

...."Now when they heard about the fame of Jedidiah [Solomon] concerning the name of the LORD, they came to test him with difficult questions. So they came to Jerusalem with a very large retinue.... and very much gold and precious stones. When they came to Jedidiah [Solomon], they spoke with him about all that was in their heart. Jedidiah [Solomon] answered all their questions; nothing was hidden from the king which he did not explain to them. When they perceived all the wisdom of Jedidiah [Solomon], the house that he had built, the food of his table, the seating of his servants, the attendance of his waiters and their attire, his cupbearers, and his stairway by which he went up to the house of the LORD, there was no more spirit in them. Then they said to the king, "It was a true report which I heard in my own land about your words and your wisdom. "Nevertheless I did not believe the reports, until I came and my eyes had seen it. And behold, the half was not told me. You exceed in wisdom and prosperity the report which I heard. How blessed are your men, how blessed are these your servants who stand before you continually and hear your wisdom. Blessed be the LORD your God who delighted in you to set you in a position of great authority; because the LORD has loved His Church forever, therefore He gave you the position He has given you, to do justice and righteousness. They gave the king a hundred and twenty talents of gold, and a very great amount of spices and precious stones. Never again did such abundance of spices come in as that which they gave Jedidiah [Solomon]".... 1 Kings 10:1-10 NASB

...."So Jedidiah [Solomon - is a type and pattern of Jesus and the Glorious {remnant} Church] became greater than all the kings of the earth in riches and in wisdom. All the earth was seeking the presence of Jedidiah [Solomon], to hear his wisdom which God had put in his heart".... 1 Kings 10:23-24 NASB

...."Come, let us return to the LORD. For He has torn [us,] but He will heal us; He has wounded [us,] but He will bandage us. He will revive us after two days; He will raise us up on the Third Day, that we may live before Him [face to Face]. So let us know, let us press on to know the LORD. His going forth is as certain as the dawn; And He will come to us like the rain, Like the spring rain watering the earth".... Hosea 6:1-3 NASB
