REFLECTIONS OF THE FATHER'S HEART

[Exhortations From The Father]

[April 15th]

* One of the Enemy's main schemes is to cause, in some way, My children to enter into a "hurried state" because it is in this state that one is not able to discern *[hear]* the still, small voice of My Spirit.

This is precisely why maintaining one's "spiritual equilibrium" *[spiritual tempo, rhythm]* at all times is of the utmost importance. For in the place of this spiritual quietness and rest My Spirit is able to bring those things *[revelations]* to one's remembrance that will keep them firmly rooted and grounded in an abiding Love.

"hurry" - to move, proceed, or act with haste *[in this case, presumptuously where God's Will is concerned]*; to impel or perform with "undue" haste;

"haste" - unnecessarily quick action; thoughtless, rash, or undue speed:

"spiritual equalibrium" - a state of rest or balance [in this case, the place wherein one's spirit and soul {mind, will, emotions} are "garrisoned about" {protected, defended} by the supernatural peace and joy of God, in faith - it is also the place wherein a continual flow of God's Grace and Wisdom abound in one's spirit {inner man}]

"rhythm" - an harmonious flow [in this case, allowing the light, Wisdom, Grace to flow smoothly into and out of one's spirit {inner man}];
