* "Hurry" does NOT produce "spiritual sensitivity". Indeed, the key "component" of spiritual sensitivity is an "abiding" *[ongoing]* quietness and stillness before Me *[and before My Word]*.

"hurry" - to impel to precipitate or thoughtless action; to urge to confused or irregular activity;

"impel" - to drive or urge forward;

"stillness" - remaining in place or at rest; free from sound or noise [in this case, the "noisy distractions" of the world]; free from turbulence or commotion; peaceful; tranquil; calm;
