REFLECTIONS OF THE FATHER'S HEART

[Exhortations From The Father]

[May 1st]

* There is a distinct difference between "factual truth" and the absolute Truth of My Word. Factual truth is based upon sense knowledge and perception - and may very well be deceptive or inaccurate.

Whereas, My divine Truth is absolute and is based upon *[discerned through]* "revelation" - and revelation, alone. Let it be understood that Truth, in reality, is the very essence of My Person *[the entirety of My True Nature and Character]*.

"sense knowledge" - that which is perceived by what one feels, hears, sees or thinks based on their outward circumstances; that which is perceived [and expressed] through the soul [mind, will, emotions] - apart from "revelation" [the Holy Spirit - Who is the Spirit of wisdom and revelation];

"truth" - conformity to fact *[factual truth]* or reality *[divine Truth - the Word of God];* exact accordance with that which is, or has been; or shall be;

"fact" - an effect produced or achieved; anything done or that comes to pass; an act; an event; a circumstance; the assertion or statement of a thing done or existing; sometimes, even when false, improperly put, by a transfer of meaning, for the thing done, or supposed to be done; a thing supposed or asserted to be done;

...."As for you, you have an anointing from the holy One [abiding within your spirit {inner man}] and have perfect [exact] knowledge [a revelation of absolute Truth]".... 1 John 2:20 Weymouth Translation

THEREFORE

...."we consider and look [speak] not to the things that are seen [the lower reality - that which is real to the five physical senses] but to the things that are unseen [through faith in the higher Reality of God's Word]; for the things that are visible are temporal (brief and fleeting) [subject to change], but the things that are invisible are deathless and everlasting [Eternal]".... 2 Corinthians 4:18 The Amplified Translation
