REFLECTIONS OF THE FATHER'S HEART

[Exhortations From The Father]

* The Enemy attempts to produce a counterfeit "clarity" [a counterfeit of the divine clarity that is an integral part of the Third Day Anointing] and, thus, if one "maintains" [through practice] a desire to lean upon their "own" understanding - thus setting their "own" path [agenda] then it is certain that through this "counterfeit spirit" of clarity that they will be convinced that I am behind their "plan" while, in reality, I am not!

Therefore, My beloved ones, guard your heart [spirit, inner man] with ALL diligence at ALL times. For truly I say to you, great clarity [divine light - and the spiritual comprehension that is its spontaneous fruit {particularly a deeper understanding of the absolute Truth of My Word - and the absoluteness of My true Nature and Character}] is about to overtake you [both individually and corporately] concerning entrance into your true Kingdom-position and the fullness of your precious destiny, in Christ.

...."Lean on, trust in, and be confident in the Lord with all your heart and mind and do not rely on your own insight or understanding [sense-knowledge and perception]. In all your ways know, recognize, and acknowledge Him [through the continual accessing of His Grace], and He [the Spirit of Grace] will direct and make straight and plain your paths".... Proverbs 3:5-6 The Amplified Translation nmc

...."Watch over your heart [spirit] with all diligence, for from it flow the springs of life [the forces of the Kingdom {Grace, Faith, Love, Truth, Righteousness and Wisdom}]".... Proverbs 4:23-24 NASB

"diligence" - constant and earnest effort to accomplish what is undertaken;

"clarity" - clearness or lucidity as to perception or understanding; freedom from indistinctness or ambiguity [vagueness];

Note: Clarity is one of the 4 chief characteristics of the Third Day anointing. The other 3 are: the impartation of godly zeal, holy fire *[divine Light] and power [the*

continual impartation of Grace].
