A "SINGLE EYE"

Words of prophecy:

* *It is certain that a "single eye" [pure and diligent heart] will ALWAYS, always produce [and receive] the needed light [revelation] - according to My highest purpose in ANY given moment.*

...."[I, Paul] do not cease giving thanks for you, while making mention of you in my prayers; that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of Him. I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you will know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, and what is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe. These are in accordance with the working of the strength of His might which He brought about in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come".... A "single eye" towards the Father and His Word produces a continual flow of light [revelation] - and fuels faith and godly desire in that one's heart. A "single eye" towards one's "self" [self-focus] produces "great" darkness - and continually fuels the ground of pride and fear in that one's life.

"fuels" - replenishes; increases;

...."where your treasure is, there will your heart be also. The light of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light. But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great is that darkness!".... Matthew 6:21-23 KJV

...."let us run with patient endurance and steady and active persistence the appointed course of the race that is set before us, looking away [from all that will distract] to Jesus, Who is the Leader and the Source of our faith [giving the first incentive for our belief] and is also its Finisher [bringing it to maturity and perfection]".... Hebrews 12:1b-2a The Amplified Translation
