## CROWN OF RIGHTEOUSNESS

\* He triumphantly shouts, "There is therefore now no condemnation to them that are in Christ Jesus." Romans 8:1. He asks this question, "Who shall lay anything to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth : who is he that condemneth ?" God did not fail in His Redemptive work. Jesus did not fail. The Spirit has not failed in His work.
